

TONER REFILL INSTRUCTIONS for :

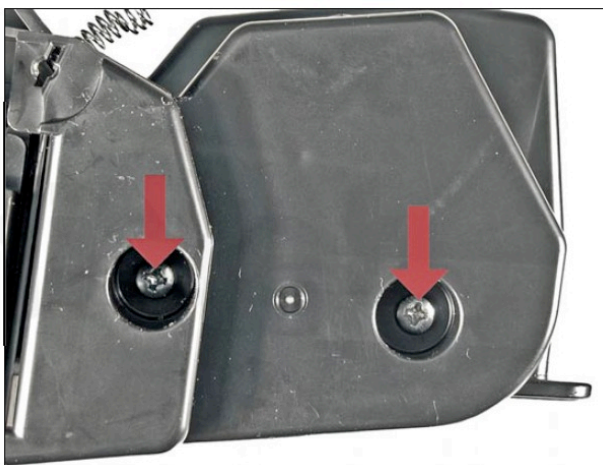

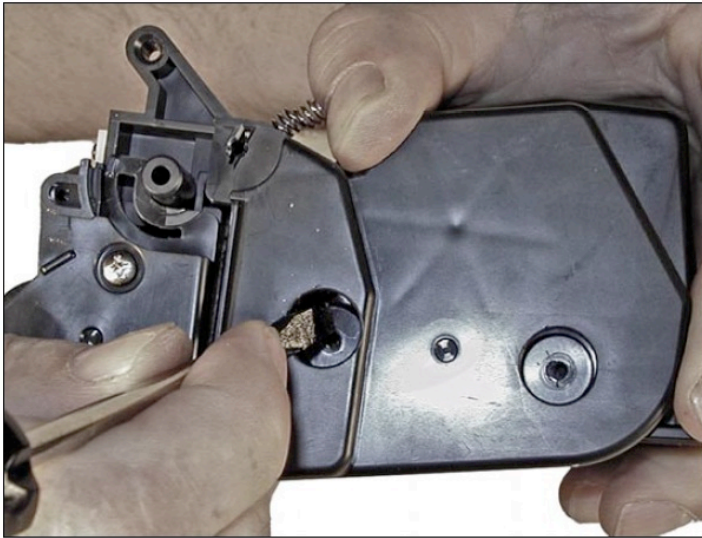

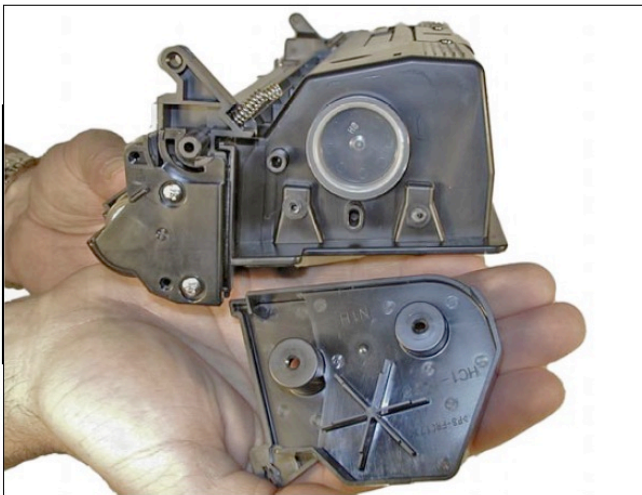
Locate Left side of Toner Cartridge, and Stand upright, supported.



Locate Screws or plastic RIVETS holding on the plastic cover section (Supply Section)



With a screwdriver, remove
Screws or plastic RIVETS to
pull back/remove the plastic
cover.



With the plastic cover section
removed, you will see the removable
Toner Plug .
(a round circular clear cap)



Pour out any remaining toner powder. Any residue will affect quality of your prints, and should not be mixed with the new REFILL TONER.

IMPORTANT: You must pour out the remaining toner powder in the cartridge as much as possible **before** refilling. Dispose of toner properly, or use a vacuum with a hose for best results (where possible). Do not overfill the cartridge by pouring the entire bottle of toner powder into the cartridge.



Pour the new REFILL TONER powder in.

Before opening the bottle of TONER, turn it upside down and tap it on a table to loosen the TONER and allow it to flow freely. Remove the cap and pull the seal off the bottle. Attach the funnel cap, making sure it is on tightly. Tilt the funnel cap toward the filling hole and insert and pour it into the hole.

If the TONER stops flowing before the cartridge is fully filled, simply remove the toner, close the cap, turn the bottle upside down and tap it on a table. Once the cartridge is fully filled, seal the hole with the plug.



Remove any spilled toner from the outside of the cartridge. Next, gently shake the cartridge side to side to distribute the toner evenly.

Finally, replace the toner cap back on, and re-install the plastic cover section (supply cover) back, and if necessary, use new metal screws to ensure it is firmly back on. (Drilling small holes, before putting in new replacement metal screws, may be necessary.) You are now ready to use the cartridge. ✓
